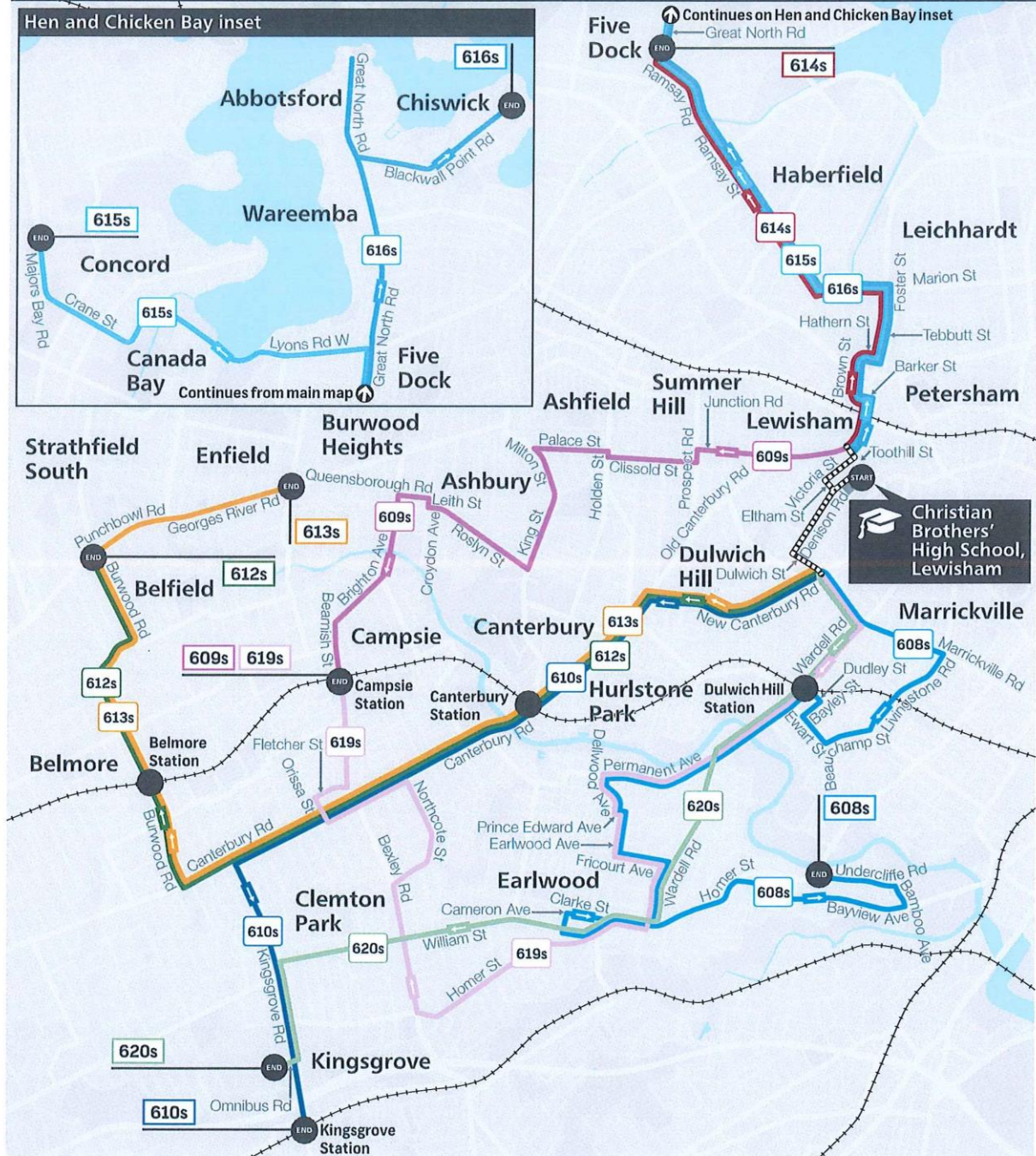

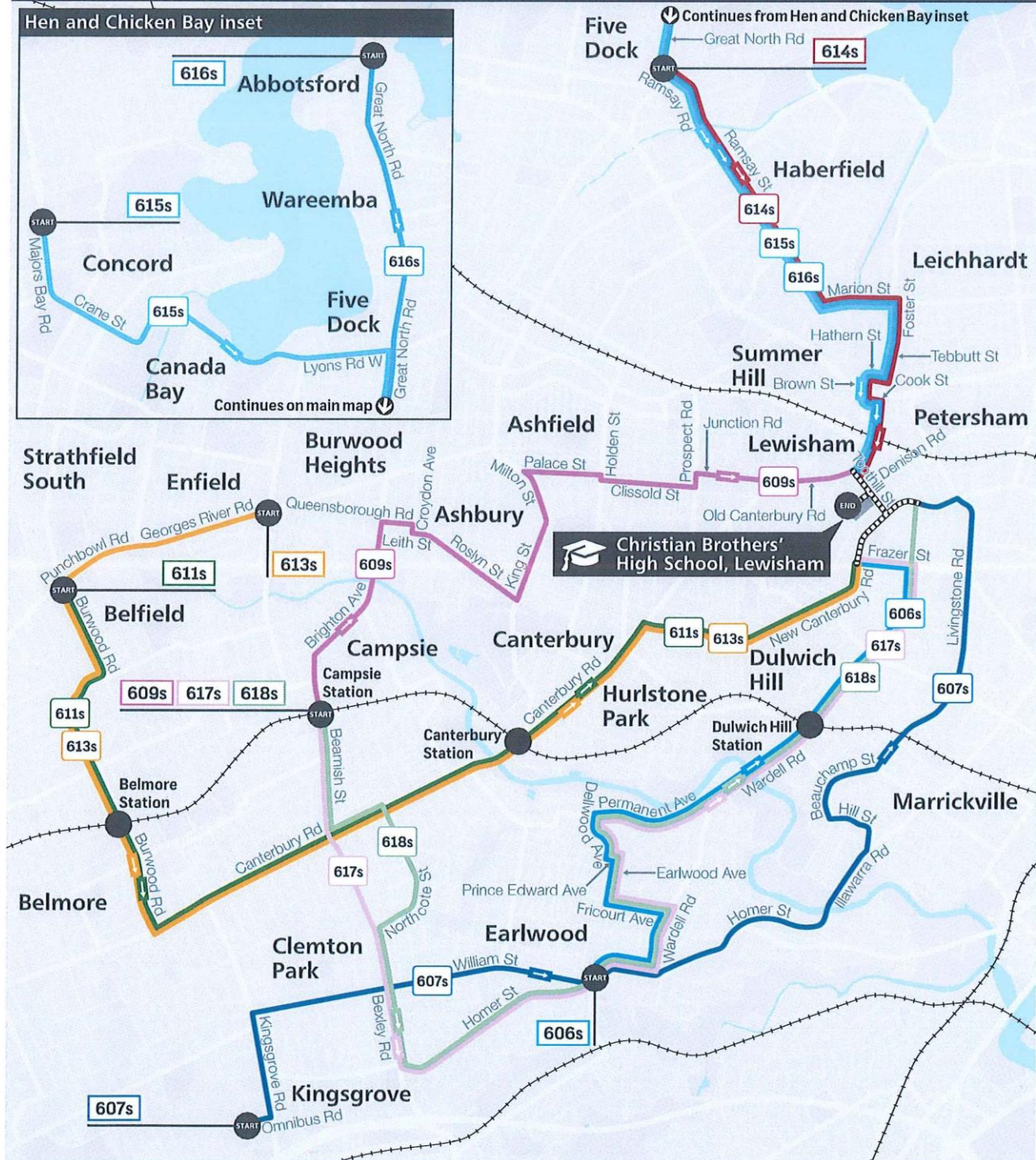
Christian Brothers' High School, Lewisham Timetable
