SECOND 607 MORNING SERVICE

We have been advised by State Transit that a **second 607 bus** will commence from next Monday 14th March 2016. The second bus will commence from Kingsgrove Road near the bus depot at 7.40am with the existing service remaining at 7.45 am.

The only change to both buses will be that they will no longer do the Bayview Ave / Undercliffe Rd loop and will instead operate directly along Homer Street. This will only affect the one bus stop on Bayview Ave with the alternative for the students from this bus stop being on Homer St near Bayview Ave, approx. 400m away.

The afternoon 608 service will continue to do the Bayview Ave/Undercliffe Rd loop.

CURRICULUM UPDATE

YEAR 8 2017 – LANGUAGES CHOICES

Each student in Year 8 is required to study one language for 100 hours (one year) to satisfy the Board of Studies, Teaching and Educational Standards NSW (BOSTES) mandatory requirements for the Record of School Achievement (RoSA).

The two languages that we will be offering in 2017 are:

- French
- Italian

In Week 9, Term 1, current Year 7 students will be required to make a selection based upon their choice from the information that has been given to them by Mrs Forbes, Language KLA Coordinator. After discussing their preference with parents, students are asked to complete the preference sheet and return to Student Services (only) by **Tuesday, 29th March 2016**. Any Year 7 student handing in his preference sheet late may miss the opportunity to gain his preferred choice.
